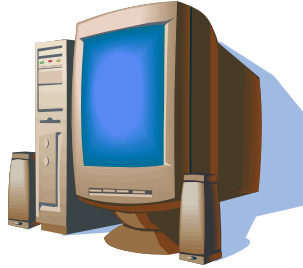

- auto fluids

### Miscellaneous:

- fluorescent light bulbs & cfl's
  - mercury thermometers
  - batteries (not auto)
  - aerosol cans
